Amidst this journey, Althea enjoys a light-hearted moment with Amber, who is decorating Paragon with intricate carvings. Their camaraderie lightens the mood but is soon tempered by somber reflections on the serpents that did not survive the perils of their adventure, including attacks from Chalcedean ships. Paragon, the liveship with a consciousness, feels the weight of these losses acutely, further deepening the emotional atmosphere on board.
