

This proposal brings her a sense of comfort; it allows her to temporarily set aside her anxieties and embrace the moment, indicating a meaningful shift in their relationship dynamics.

As they return to the vibrant atmosphere of the prom, the protagonist gains a sense of hope. Instead of being burdened solely by love and loyalty, she begins to view her journey as one of exploration and growth, suggesting that perhaps the clarity she seeks will come with time, while the weight of immediate decisions can be set aside for now. With a renewed perspective, she feels that navigating her relationships could become less about choosing one path over another, but rather about embracing the journey ahead with all its uncertainties.
